Over 1500 reports from 94 countries participated in the competition. The focus in 2022 is Food & Beverage, a sector that has become essential. The reports are screened for their content, clear writing, easy readership, quality production. They are compared as books. They are not rated individually for sustainability promises or solutions.

"Sustainability Reports are books that should be widely read", says Edouard Cointreau, President and Founder of the Hallbars Sustainability Research Institute. Hallbar means Sustainable in Swedish" Sustainability Reports usually have an ISBN, with great budgets for writing and production, with high quality. They deserve to be well distributed and promoted. They give a positive view of the green future for the planet, our children and their children ».

"As a member of the Hallbars Awards ' Jury ,I am very happy to highlight that the number and quality of the reports coming from Latin America has significantly increased " says Guillermo Gonzales , Hallbars ' Ambassador for Latin America(LATAM).Gonzales also added ; "Latin America has almost the double of prizes in comparison to the previous Halbars Awards presented.This is the result of the great effort done in the region to promote the accomplishment of United Nations Sustainable Goals( SDGs). This effort is focused on the reduction of poverty and inequality and in the creation of job opportunities under decent conditions plus a good quality of life."

The next step is the publication of the interactive book Hallbars Awards 2022 on October 21, 2022, the birthday of Alfred Nobel, from his last residence, the Karlskoga Alfred Nobel House Museum. "The book is an annual bestseller for digital technical textbooks:" says Edouard Cointreau." it had over 6000 downloads over the past year. The next Hallbars Awards 2022 book will be enhanced and even more interactive."

The Hallbars Awards ceremony is November 26, 2022 in Angkor, Siem Reap, Cambodia.
